Deadline: All scholarship applications must be received at the Main Office (1616 Whitten Road) by March 12, 2010.

Requirements:

Applicants/Recipients must be:

- Primary members of LGWFCU in good standing.
- High school seniors graduating in Spring 2010
- Planning to enter an accredited college, university, or vocational school as full-time freshmen in Fall 2010

*Potential applicants who are not already members of LGWFCU may qualify to join as an immediate family member (which includes spouse, child, parent, sibling, grandparent, grandchild, stepparent, stepchild, stepsibling, and adoptive relationships) of an MLGW employee or retiree.

Employees and volunteers of L G & W Federal Credit Union and their family members are not eligible to apply.

The four scholarships are one-time awards and are not renewable for future school years.

Selection

A selection committee made up of an LGWFCU board member, President/CEO, exempt employee, and hourly employee will select the scholarship recipients. Judging is based solely on the essay. The essay is judged on content, creativity, and clarity.

Scholarship winners will be notified by April 18, 2010. Winners will also be announced at the LGWFCU Annual Meeting on April 18, 2010. Non-winners will be notified by letter.

Scholarship funds are disbursed directly to the school to be applied to tuition, fees, books, and or on-campus housing on behalf of the recipient. There is no cash disbursement to the student. Scholarship funds are good for freshmen status student for Fall 2010, Spring 2011 semesters only.

Note: Financial need of the applicant and income of the applicant's parents are not considered in the scholarship selections. Selections are based solely on the essay.
