Requirements:

Applicants must be:

- High school seniors graduating in Spring 2019
Planning to enter an accredited college, university, or vocational school as a full-time freshman in the Fall of 2019
Primary members of LGWFCU in good standing OR eligible to join as an immediate family member (which includes spouse, child, stepchild(ren), parent, sibling, grandparent, and grandchild) of an MLGW employee or retiree.

Employees and volunteers of L G & W Federal Credit Union and their family members are not eligible to apply.

The four scholarships are one-time awards and are not renewable

Selection

A selection committee made up of an LGWFCU board member(s), a Supervisory Committee member(s), and an employee(s) of LGWFCU will select the scholarship recipients. Judging is based solely on the essay. The essay is judged on content, creativity, and clarity.

Scholarship winners will be notified by March 15, 2019. Scholarships will be awarded at the LGWFCU Annual Meeting on April 7, 2019. Recipients must be a primary member of LGWFCU in good standing and be present to receive their award. Non-winners will be notified by letter.

Scholarship funds are disbursed directly to the school to be applied to tuition, fees, books, and or on-campus housing on behalf of the recipient. There is no cash disbursement to the student. Scholarship funds are good for freshman status student for Fall 2019 semester only.

Note: Financial need of the applicant and income of the applicant's parents are not considered in the scholarship selections. Selections are based solely on the essay.
